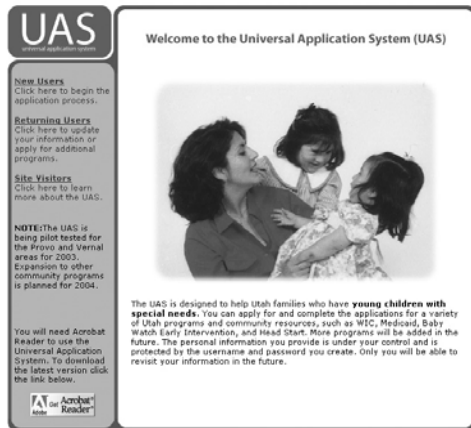


The UAS is a web-based application process designed for Utah families

who have young children with special needs. Families can complete applications online for a variety of Utah programs and community resources. The UAS is confidential and protected by the username and password you create. Only you will be able to revisit your information once it is entered into the system.

Where can I use the UAS?

- The UAS can be used in agency offices, at home, or in public buildings such as libraries or schools or anywhere you have Internet access.
- The application process can be completed when it is most convenient for you. The system is available 24 hours a day.



How do I use the UAS?

1. Register

- Log on to the website at www.utahclicks.org
- You will be asked for your first and last name, as well as a username and password of your choice.
- Your registration information will be saved and will allow you to update your information in the future as needed.
- Write down your username and password. You will need them to login upon returning to the site.

2. Apply

- As you start the application process, the UAS will ask you some questions.
- Based on your answers, a list of programs for which you may be eligible will be displayed.
- After you select the programs that interest you, the UAS will ask you for additional information required by the programs.
- You will not be required to enter the same information twice and you are not required to enter any information you do not want to.

3. Print and Submit

- When you finish answering all the questions, the UAS will display a link to each of the applications you completed.
- Click the link to the form you want to print. Each form will be displayed with instructions on how and where to submit it. Just click on the print button on the web browser window.



Can I submit my application online?

Currently, completed applications can not be sent electronically to the agencies, yet this is a future goal.

How long does it take?

Approximately one hour, depending on the programs you apply for. You can save your progress at any time.
